JCL - who are we? The Japanese remain among the world's least-reached people but we at JCL are passionate about helping to change that. We were founded as the **Japan Evangelistic Band (JEB)** in 1903 and, through God's grace, JEB work led to establishing over 150 churches and the Kansai Bible College. In 1999 our mission evolved into its current form, adopting the new name of '**Japan Christian Link' (JCL)** for much of our global activity. Historic work in Japan in the Kansai region continues independently under the JEB name, with support from some JCL partners, while other JCL partners work elsewhere in Japan too. We equip, mentor and encourage Christians in reaching and discipling the Japanese. Our partners and volunteers also share the gospel through church work, through 'tentmaking' mission work, or informally with friends and colleagues. We are interdenominational, international and inclusive, seeking to work with other like-minded organisations. Our prayerful aim is to see a significant difference in the progress of the gospel among the Japanese people over the first half of this century.

Our venue is All Nations Christian College, an historic main house (opposite) set in beautiful grounds. Our guest speaker is Akira Sato, pastor of Fukushima First Bible Baptist Church, formerly 3 miles from the now notorious nuclear power plant.

Following the triple disaster in 2011, the congregation were forced to leave, and many will never be able to return to their former homes. Although they now have a new church building in a safer location, about 70 of the members spent two 'homeless' years, on the move together without a church building or homes of their own. On their journey however, they learned deep truths about 'home' and about being 'church' - being a community of believers. Join us this July to learn from their experiences and to gain a better understanding of the current spiritual climate and Christian scene in Japan.

There will be plenty of input in Japanese so do invite your Japanese friends. The programme will include workshops, testimonies and good time to relax, chat and get to know one another - a great opportunity to meet different people involved in outreach to Japanese, as well as to make new friends and renew old acquaintances.
